Students will learn the administrative fundamentals of Bradford Campus Manager and be able to effectively configure the integrated software applications. This includes setting security, access control, and usage policies.

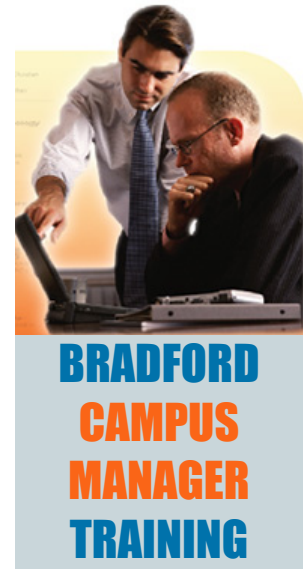
